The proposed 2545 NE 200th St. site is surrounded by neighborhoods with young children and is unsuitable as a location for a jail. Yesterday, Dec 19th there were 30+ kids sledding on the proposed site from the neighboring apartments and multistory single-family homes. The point is not that the kids could not find another hill to sled on, but that the site is surrounded by families with young children who would be in close proximity to the proposed jail and the traffic that would be going in to it, and out of it. Walk by this site on any day after school and you will see kids walking up and down 30th Ave NE. It would be a mistake to have the people who frequent a jail site in the middle of this neighborhood in contact with these kids.
